



Wordpress (WooCommerce)

Upload the unpacked plugin (folder with the plugin) to the server with the site to the “/wp-content/plugins” folder or using the download through the site admin panel.

Betatransfer	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>	Payment through Betatransfer.

Check payments	<input type="checkbox"/>	Take payments in person via checks. This offline gateway can be useful to test purchases.
Cash on delivery	<input type="checkbox"/>	Have your customers pay with cash (or by other means) upon delivery.
